Summary:

It is time for clinical laboratories to incorporate data analytics as a core component of their service or operations, moving beyond transactional creation and use of data to developing insights and providing knowledge or wisdom from data that informs decision making.

This activity will introduce key concepts in data analytics. It will describe ways that clinical laboratorians can build capacity for data analytics and experts in lab medicine can build data literacy and fluency. Examples of why this is important will be discussed.
